Mint is a fertility and water loving species. For this reason, they may be best grown in large pots with organic matter rich soil for many gardeners if it is hard to obtain these growing conditions in the ground. Dappled shade may be beneficial, especially during heat waves. Rhizomes received from us can simply be coiled up and planted in a small pot or directly planted into soil that will be kept wet. Mint #1 will survive over the long haul in Florida but every so often needs to be regenerated by getting moved into a new spot with some runners from the old patch. Plants are much more haggard looking in the summer and perform best in the coolest months of the year. We would consider this more of a high maintenance plant to keep near the house or in the vegetable garden and not something that is going to do well stuck out in the lesser visited corners of the garden.
